



### **COVID-19 Guidelines for recreation**

The Fieldhouse Family Sports and Recreation Center will follow all updated guidelines and recommendations from the State of Ohio, Ohio Health Department, Muskingum County Health Department and CDC. Please help us follow all the guidelines so we can all safely enjoy the sports we all love and have missed playing.

- Players, coaches, and officials must conduct daily symptom assessments before each practice or game. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- Spectators consist of ONLY mom and dad (no siblings/ grandparents) NO EXCEPTIONS (u10 and up 2 parents, u8 and instructional 1 parent ONLY)
- No congregating before or after practices or games by players, coaches, officials is permitted.
- Spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home. Family members must sit together, socially distanced from other individuals/family
- Players, coaches, and officials are not to physically contact each other before or after practice, pregame and competitive play (i.e. greetings, team huddles, high-fives, congregating, etc.).
- All PARENTS are required to sign a new waiver before participating in a league.
- Athletes are to arrive NO more than 15 minutes before the start of a scheduled game.
- Athletes will follow instructions for entering and exiting the fields once they arrive.
- Face masks are required while in the facility with the following exceptions: 1) the start of the game.
- If athletes or guests have a family member with a medical history that places them in a high-risk category for COVID-19, we recommend that they DO NOT play or enter the facility.
- Athletes should leave valuables/personal items at home as we will no longer maintain a Lost & Found.
- If athletes bring in a water bottle, they need to boldly label with their name and do not share. NO BAGS ALLOWED IN FACILITY. Cleats need to be carried in and placed along side of outside wall of field.
- Athletes must wash hands or use hand sanitizer before taking the field. Hand sanitizer stations are available throughout the facility and on the sidelines. They should avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Athletes must come dressed to play so they can get on the field without using the locker rooms.

- Spitting on the field or elsewhere in the facility is prohibited and will result in ejection from the facility and a two-game suspension. Play will stop, but not the clock, so that the affected area of the field can be sanitized.
- Pinnies will not be provided by the facility. Goalies MUST wear their own shirt.
- Athletes are to avoid physical contact with others including handshakes, high fives, huddles or other close contact before, during or after games.
- Game balls will be sanitized before the start of play, at halftime and after the game. Player benches will be sanitized after each game.
- The upper-level spectator deck will be marked off with cones 6 feet apart where parents may view game. Please maintain social distancing.
- The Fieldhouse staff will wear masks and will routinely sanitize high touch points throughout each shift.
- There will be NO refunds or credits given unless a state shutdown is implemented by Governor DeWine. In accordance with other recreation facilities we are following the same guidelines that if a child on your team tests positive and the team is forced to quarantine the game will not be made up and no refunds will be issued.
- Spectators refusing to wear a face mask will result in a forfeit for your team and game will be canceled.
- The facility is being cleaned with top of the line 3m 41A chemical with this on the EPA N list to be effective for Covid in 5 minutes. The fields will be sanitized at least twice a day.
